



North West Junior Commission: North West team selection policy for the Junior Inter Regional Regatta 2026 – UPDATED 25 November 2025

Background

The North West has a fantastic history with the Junior Inter Regionals and is proud of the athletes selected to represent us each year. Our performances since 2009 are below:

Selection for the 2026 team will follow the process below:

1) Selection of single scullers will occur at a separate time trial (NWJTT1x) on Sunday, the 25th of January 2026, at The Grange from 12 noon. It will be a single division timetrial over 1500m. We will require volunteers from across the clubs to support this (2 per club please). Entries will be done online in BROE2. Clubs to enter a maximum of 3 rowers per event.

As each age category has 2 positions, the second position will be filled by the captains based on performances at the time trial, as well as other events held in the region.

2) North West Junior Time Trial (NWJTT), Sunday the 8th of March 2026, held at Northwich over 1500 metres, will close out the selection of the NW JIRR team. All clubs are invited to participate so that we have fair representation of all the clubs in the North West. One entry per club per event. It will be at the discretion of the Team Manager and Boys and girls Captain to allow extra crews into the event. Again, composite crews encouraged following observations from JHN and the single sculler selection (NWJTT1x).

Details about the two selection events (NWJTT1x and NWJTT 2025)

- 1) Entries will be done online in BROE2;
 - a. For the single event entries will be open 2nd week in January.
 - b. For the crew boat event, entries will be open 1st week in February.
- 2) Must supply the coach's email address and phone number for each crew as this will be used to discuss crew selection.
- 3) Two volunteers are required from each competing club for each division (2 for the single event and 4 for the crew event). You will not be allowed to race if you do not provide volunteers.
- 4) Pay online through BROE2 before the event. SCR before the draw will be refunded.
- 5) Add a t-shirt size for each athlete on BROE2.
- 6) Entries will be suspended:
 - a. For the single event on the 18th of January 2026
 - b. For the crew boat event on Sunday, 22nd February 2026, 9 p.m. for up to 24 hours; the entry numbers and the point of suspension will be released only to those that made entries; coaches can then change/add crews until entries close on Sunday, 2nd March (this is in order to give the region the best chance to have our most competitive team ever).
- 7) One of the divisions will be made available for racing composite crews, rowers and coaches to ensure they are available for the entire day. Captains may invite / accept additional entries on the day to race in DIV 3 to help select a strong NW Junior team Orange.

The Junior Inter-Regional Regatta (JIRR) is on Saturday, 25th April 2026, at Nottingham. Please ensure all athletes entered at the timetrial can attend the JIRR and their British rowing membership is up to date in April.

Results

Competitors/coaches should understand that winning your category does not necessarily guarantee you are selected, as other factors may need to be considered in the selection process.

Competitors/ coaches should also understand that they are racing all in a boat class and not just in age group; the selectors can promote younger juniors up a class if they beat older age groups.

Athletes can race in 2 divisions, so doubling is allowed. Please advise Captains and on the entry form the preference to the event if successful.

After the event, club coaches will be notified of crews successful in gaining selection; this will be no longer than one week after the event. Please make sure the coach of the crew or athlete has their contact details, email, and phone number.

The team captain can fill any empty slots to produce a full squad.

The team captain can create composite boats to represent the North West from eligible crews.

Complaints

Complaints will only be considered from club coaches to the relevant team captains (Girls and Boys). The Team Captains will have the final say on team selection. This policy has been formed to be a basis for selecting the NW team for all junior coaches to know the process to attain this target. Creating a policy for all eventualities is impractical, so this document looks at the major items. Wherever there is ambiguity, the guiding principle must be to select the best team.
