First Aid provision – to be finalised & expected to be via up to 4 safety launches and each club having a first aid provision (e.g. via their qualified Junior Coaches).

First Aid locations

- Water Sports Centre (WSC) Medical Room (also includes AED)
- Agecroft RC office
- Agecroft RC boathouse
- Every safety launch

In addition to first aid kits each safety launch Marshals and Umpires will have radios, loudhailers, throw lines available. Launches will also have a standard rowSAFE launch kit, including foil blankets.

Should an AED be required, the radios should be used to contact the medical officer. AED will be located at the club (in the entrance to Water Sports Centre).

However this video is for the full Agecroft Head and should be watched remembering that for the NWJTT the race will START at “the Black Footbridge” and finish at “the Metro line bridge” so please view the video knowing the START and FINISH lines are

Communication

All marshals & umpires will be equipped with radios and mobile phones and will use the radio protocol in the event of an emergency. In the event of radio failure, mobile phones will be used.

Accident and Emergency Procedures

The Water Sports Centre (WSC) has [Defibrillation equipment](#) (AED device).

The competition will provide a ‘lead first aider’ – stationed at the boathouse - available on the radio with a call for “medic”. *** Coaches, please bring your own first-aid kit to support your athlete(s) ***; should coaches be missing kit equipment or need support they are asked to contact any official with radio to call the “medic” (First aid lead).

Fire

Fire Alarm ‘Break glasses’ are located throughout the building and at all exits/doors to both the Agecroft RC and WSC. Alarm will sound. Everyone must vacate the building and return to their trailer and wait until a roll call from your club officials and remain there until dismissed by event safety advisor.
